## **“Gati’s Arbitral Award in Air India matter Upheld”**

**Hyderabad, July 8, 2015:** “Gati Limited India's pioneer and leader in Express Distribution and Supply Chain Business has informed that in a long drawn legal battle, the Hon'ble Delhi High Court had pronounced its order in favor of Gati, on Air India's Application under Section 34 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 and upheld the award of the Arbitral Tribunal, except the claim for damages. The detailed Order of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court is awaited.

It was in May 2007 that Gati had partnered with Air India for dedicated freighter service. Due to certain dispute the service had to be discontinued from March 2009. The matter was referred to Arbitration.

The said Arbitral Tribunal had passed its award on 17th September, 2013 directing Air India to pay a net sum of Rs.26.82 Crores towards claims, damages, interest and costs. Also, the Arbitral Tribunal had said that in the event of Air India failing to comply with the Award within 30 days from the date of Award, Air India shall be liable to pay interest @ 18% p. a thereafter.”
