Express distribution and supply chain management company Gati has reported a net loss of Rs 2.75 crore for the quarter ended June 30 as against a profit of Rs 6.59 crore in the corresponding period last year.


Its revenues from operations for the April-June quarter marginally declined to Rs 426.19 crore from Rs 431 crore reported in Q1 FY2023.

"Our express business continues to deliver a resilient performance driven by positive momentum in volumes. Q1FY24 volumes were up 5 per cent y-o-y despite a strong base quarter. The previous quarter benefitted from exceptional volumes driven by industry consolidation that benefitted few players," Pirojshaw (Phil) Sarkari, MD and CEO of GESCPL said.

He further said that the positive sales momentum will continue in the coming months and to augment our infrastructure build-up efforts, Gati will launch its Bangalore hub in the third week of this month.
